Class Registration Policy

1. Class space is limited to **registered participants only**.
2. You must register for all classes. This includes Know-How Classes as well as Viking Club, Embroidery Club, Designer Club, Serger Club, etc.
3. **Payment must be made 1 week in advance of the class.** Preparations have been made for you to be in the class.
4. Please be on time to class. You should arrive 15 minutes early to set up your work station.
5. It is illegal to copy printed materials for use in class or to embroider a design not owned by the person embroidering it. Each student is required to own/purchase a copy of the required book, pattern or embroidery design.
6. A 20% discount on any pattern, book or embroidery design required by a class will be given on the day of the class or whenever the kit is picked up if preparation for the class is required.
